2026 Alabama Learning Trip



Join Jobs to Move America from October 5-9th for a transformative trip through Alabama, the center of the civil rights movement and the growing Black-led worker justice movement. This is an opportunity to significantly contribute to the worker organizing and corporate accountability fight in the Deep South, and take a deeper dive into the history, culture and community building of the Southern labor movement.

Alabama has a rich and complex civil rights and labor history. It's important to see it and learn in person in order to truly understand the significance of organizing in the South, and the promise of what is possible when we all join in the movement.

Places and experiences that will be included in the itinerary:

- **Montgomery:** the home base for JMA's Recall Injustice Campaign and the heart of the nation's Civil Rights History. See the vision for JMA's 2026 campaigns, visit the Legacy Museum, and meet workers, coalition members, and community partners who are leading the new Southern worker movement from within.
- **Anniston:** where the Ku Klux Klan bombed and beat a bus full of Freedom Riders in 1961; industrial giant Monsanto knowingly poisoned residents from toxic chemical production; and site of the New Flyer electric vehicle factory where JMA negotiated a historic Community Benefits Agreement for thousands of workers and the community.
- **Tallapoosa:** a small historic mill town along the Tallapoosa River, known for its deep manufacturing roots, tight-knit community, and proximity to the Thurlow Dam and surrounding rural landscapes. The site of JMA's Neptune Campaign, addressing labor and environmental issues the community faces.
- Along the way, learn the history of Black worker organizing that has led to the movement of today, spoken through community, civil rights and labor leaders on the ground fighting for a better Alabama.

When: October 5th - 9th. New participants are encouraged to experience the trip in its entirety. If you are returning and have already visited Anniston, you have the option of attending from October 6th - 9th for a reduced price. The shorter itinerary skips the day in Anniston and will include only JMA's new campaigns.

What's Included: Lodging, meal, and tour expenses

- Covered trip expenses include 4 nights hotel stay, ground transportation and meals.
- Also includes tours, activities, guest speakers/guides who are history, civil rights and labor experts.
- JMA will plan, book, and coordinate trip programming, activities, lodging and select meals.
- **Airfare is *not* included.** Participants should make their own arrangements to travel to Montgomery, AL.
- Price covers estimated expenses per person. An additional charitable contribution to help fuel JMA's Southern work and grow our movement is optional.
